1. Enrollment Process for 2024-25

- It is important to know that educators will not be able to sign into the screening and reporting website until new enrollment information for the 2024-25 school year is processed.
- When your district technology representative is ready to have the OAISD process their 2024-25 district enrollments, please complete the “**2024-2025 District Enrollments**” form, located on the [Contact Us](#) page.
 - Contacts will be notified with their enrollment status after their enrollment information is processed.
- Please coordinate with your district’s technology representative to complete the following steps.
 - Verify that your district’s student information system has been changed over to the new school year.
 - For MI school districts using the MIDataHub, verify that the MIDataHub Delta Math Integration is receiving course enrollment information for the upcoming school year.
 - For school districts sending enrollment files, prepare the first set of enrollment files for the upcoming school year.
 - Transfer the **MIDataHub key and secret** or **enrollment files** to the OAISD SFTP folder for your district.

2. Online Management Videos

3. Implementation Support for New Educators

- To support new educators who are planning to implement Delta Math RtI Program resources this school year, we are offering access to the recording of a past implementation training on Zoom.
- To allow for targeted exploration, this [2.5 hour video](#) has been edited into smaller sections to allow educators more flexibility and efficiency to learn about each implementation topic.
- Each topic addresses one of the following professional learning questions:
 - What should students know and be able to do?
 - How will we know if students have unfinished learning?
 - How can we help students complete unfinished learning?

- After viewing the videos, please let me know if you have follow-up questions I may answer through email. We can also meet on Zoom to discuss any topics if you prefer.

4. Kindergarten Readiness Screeners and Number Sense

- The kindergarten readiness screener is designed as a one-on-one interview. Educators can record student responses directly into the student's online screener, or they can record student responses on paper to transfer into the online screener at a later time.
- The Delta Math RtI Program [Number Sense Overview](#) was recently developed to support educators in their understanding of number sense. This document includes visual models that are integrated throughout Delta Math RtI Program intervention lessons and targeted practice. Quick links are also provided to download instructional resources for each number sense readiness standard.
- Progress monitoring resources for the kindergarten readiness standards are not yet available. We will do our best to work on them during the upcoming school year.
